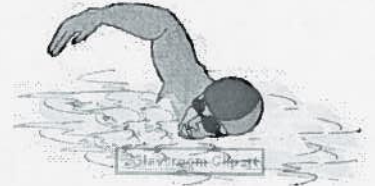

# Principal's Message

I would like to remind everyone that, with the wonderful spring weather, puddle season is upon us. Please ensure that your child(ren) are dressed for what promises to be a very wet spring. Being warm and dry makes a much more enjoyable day for everyone!

I would like to extend a huge thank you to the Brandl family for arranging for our surprise visitor in March, Keith Shologan of the Saskatchewan Roughriders. His messages were very timely for our students. He spoke of what it was like to be singled out and bullied for being different. He also gave a terrific sense of hope to our students as he spoke of the difference his determination, hard work, and willingness to work with his team mates and coaches, made in his life. One suggestion, from an older student, who suggested that he try football, was the turning point in his life, although he also spoke of the many wonderful people he had the opportunity to work with throughout his career. It was a tremendous afternoon.

As we settle back in for the final three months of the school year, we will be focusing on diligence and cooperation. Diligence, a virtue of hard work and persistence which Keith spoke about, helps students realize what is important and what they need to do to be successful.
